Uniquely Tel Aviv

Stroll in **Neve Tzedek**, Tel Aviv's new hip neighborhood where the intellectual elite lived during Israel's early days, take a special **tour of the Yitzhak Rabin Center**, built in a downward spiral, the museum presents two parallel stories: Israel's history and society, and the biography of Yitzhak Rabin. Explore the **Old Port City of Jaffa** (Yafo), and tour the **Israel Defense Force Museum** situated on the old railway station in Yaffo. Visit the spiritually moving Independence Hall and have a special evening at the **Nalaga'at Center** home to a one-of-a-kind theater, featuring the *Deaf-blind Acting Ensemble* and dine in a pitch-black restaurant, **BlackOut**, with its staff of blind waiters.

Caesarea, Akko, Safed & So Much More!

While traveling north, visit an **IDF Dog Unit** that specializes in training and handling dogs for military applications and make a stop at **Kibbutz Ein Shemer** to experience kibbutz life and learn how it's changed over time. Drive to the ancient city of **Caesarea**, built by Herod the Great and once the seat of Roman rule. Continue on to **Zichron Ya'akov**, where you'll see the home of Aharon Aaronson and his sisters Sarah and Rebecca, leaders of the Jewish secret organization *Nili*, that spied for Britain against the Ottoman Turks during WWI. Spend an evening in the beach town of **Nahariya**, see the ancient crusader port city of **Akko**, travel to **Rosh Hanikrah** on the northern boarder and take a cable car to the grottos, formed from an ongoing geological process over thousands of years.

Experience the mystical city of **Safed**, the birthplace of Kabbalah, and one of the *Four Holy Cities* according to Kabalistic studies. Visit the **Hula Valley Nature Reserve** where tens of thousands of birds and more than 200 species of water fowl make their home. Walk the trails at **Tel Dan National Reserve**, make a special stop at **Oz 77**—the most important memorial in the **Golan Heights** for the 1973 Yom Kippur War. Overnight in **Kfar Blum** and see **Katzrin**, the "Capital of the Golan" to walk in this Talmudic village and learn about the Temple period.








Jordon's Ancient Cities

Take the Sheich Hussein border crossing into **Jordan** and visit the **ancient city of Jarash** which boasts an unbroken chain of human occupation dating back over 6.500 years. Continue along the 5,000 year old *King's Highway*, passing through a string of ancient sites. The first city along the way is **Madaba**, **"The City of Mosaics"** which has been intermittently inhabited for nearly 3,500 years. See the memorial of Moses, and the presumed site of the prophet's death and burial place. Make your way to **Petra**, one of the seven wonders of the world with its Neolithic ruins to the desert castles of Umayyad Princes. A highlight among these treasures is the soul stirring, rose-red city of Petra, now a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Masada, Ein Gedi, Shabbat in Jerusalem...

Stay on a kibbutz then visit Massada and ascend by cable car to see the ancient synagogue and fortress. Travel to the beautiful **Ein Gedi Reserve**, an oasis in the desert then onto Jerusalem. Stop at a overlook of the Old City, to celebrate our arrival with a special She'hecheyanu ceremony, to offer thanks for new and unusual experiences. Enter the Old City to the Southern Wall Excavations and the Davidson Center, one of the most significant archeological sites in the country. Descend through the many layers of Jerusalem's past while walking in the Western Wall Tunnels. Stand on the site believed to be the nearest spot to the "Holy of Holies" and see the City of David's latest excavations of Jerusalem during the time of the first Temple period. In Emek Tzurim spend a few hours taking part in the archaeological dig of the Temple Mount. Visit the Herzl Vision Museum and Yad Vashem with a private guided tour of the new Holocaust History Museum. Enjoy Machane Yehuda Market's colors, smells and unique atmosphere as the city prepares for Shabbat the enjoy your private Shabbat dinner. During your final day walk the Jerusalem neighborhoods and see the renovated Israel Museum. Have a beautiful farewell dinner at Anna Ticho restaurant.



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
